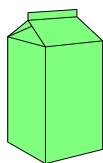

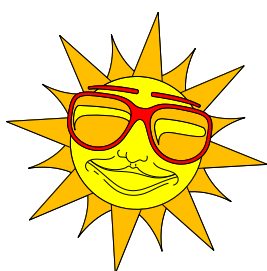
Snack Time

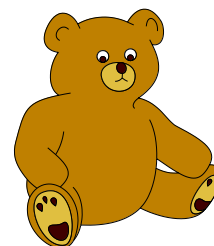

Reception Class Times

The Reception children will attend for whole days, after the initial induction period. They will be able to have a school meal at lunchtime or bring a packed lunch from home. School meals are free for all children in the reception class.

Religious Education



During the year we will help the children to discover signs of God in their experience of themselves, the world and others.

In the reception R.E programme we try to develop in the children attitudes of love, praise and thanks towards God Our Father, as well as attitudes of awe and wonder at the beauty and variety of His creation.

We aim to develop in the children a relationship with God Our Father and the children are encouraged to pray to God each day. They will learn simple formal prayers and have

opportunities for silent and spontaneous prayer and for praying through gesture or action.

The children will also be taught about the main events in the life of Jesus.

School Uniform

The Reception children should wear school uniform. Please put your child's name in all items.



Boys

Navy school jumper or cardigan preferably with the school logo
Grey trousers or shorts
White shirt
School tie
Grey socks if wearing shorts
Black school shoes



Girls

Navy jumper
or cardigan preferably with the school logo
Grey pinafore dress/skirt or grey trousers
White shirt
School tie
Grey or white socks/tights
Black school shoes

Light blue summer dress (optional)

Clothes for other activities

The Reception children will be taking part in P.E. lessons.

They will need to come to school wearing the following P.E kit on their P.E day:

Black unbranded jogging bottoms or shorts

Plain white T-shirt

Black unbranded sweatshirt or hoodie

Trainers or pumps with Velco fastening (no laces please)

As with all uniform, please clearly label PE kit with your child's name.

The children will often be going out to play and will need suitable clothing for this e.g. a coat, hat and gloves in cold weather or a sunhat in warmer weather.

Other Information

For the safety of your child only adults are allowed to bring and fetch the children in the Nursery and Reception classes.

Please tell us if someone different is coming for your child by contacting the school office.

Birthdays

We love to celebrate birthdays with the children. So that everyone knows to say a big 'Happy Birthday!' to your child, they may choose to come to school wearing their own clothes instead of their uniform. If your child's birthday falls on the weekend or in a holiday, they may wear their own clothes on the nearest day. Children may bring in birthday sweets to share with their friends if they wish.
