On Tuesday 17th March children are invited to come into school wearing something green for a £1 donation towards Lenten charities which can be paid through the Eduspot – Shop.

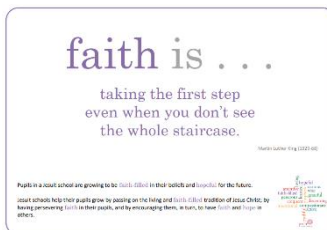
Irish Dancing Assembly

Values and Virtues – Faith-filled and Hopeful



This term we will be focussing on being Faith-filled and Hopeful.
