Dear Parents and Carers,

What is the Cost of the School Day project?

Poverty affects more than one in four children in the UK today. When children grow up poor they miss out – and so do the rest of us. We have been working across the UK to make sure that schools are set up so that children don't miss out and don't feel different or excluded because of how much money their family has.

We'll be supporting your child's school to reduce and remove financial barriers to learning and poverty-related stigma, ensuring every child can make the most of the school day regardless of their household income.

Poverty Proofing the School Day

We are currently working with Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic Primary School to support the school to 'poverty proof' the school day. This means helping the whole-school community to work together to identify best practice as well cost barriers to learning and take actions to remove them. We are speaking to a number of pupils, teachers and governors and would like to get your views as parents too. We will be discussing things such as access to trips, after school clubs and music tuition, the costs of uniform, how free school meals are administered and how students access food during the school day.
