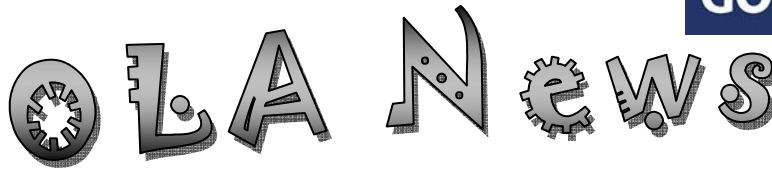

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Governors,



**General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** - The Data Protection law is changing and we want to keep you up to date with the steps our school is taking. On the 25th May the General Data Protection Regulation, known as GDPR, comes into effect. GDPR imposes additional obligations on organisations, including schools on

how pupil data is used and stored.

We want you to know that we respect the information we hold on our pupils and that we take the security of their information very seriously. Lots of the information we keep on pupils is mandatory through the Education Act 1996 e.g date of birth, home address, contact details, assessment data etc.

We have recently published a new Privacy Notice to give you more information on the data we hold on pupils, what we do with that data, who we share that data with and the new rights under GDPR.

Our updated Privacy Notice is now on our school website under Key Information.
