This year the parish Christmas Bazaar will be held on 23rd November in the school hall. Please come along with your family and friends to support the parish, visit Santa and have some fun. We look forward to seeing you there.

Could your child be entitled to free school meals?

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. You may be aware that families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. However, you may not be aware that pupils who are eligible for free school meals also attract funding for the school. **Every child who is eligible for free school meals raises an extra £1,320 for school to fund valuable support and resources like reading books, equipment, support with trips, additional teaching staff or after school activities.**

Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

If you think you may be eligible, we need you to make an application (even if your child is already getting free school meals because they are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2). This can be done online at https://www.coventry.gov.uk/info/54/benefits/168/free_school_meals/2

If you pop into school, we will be happy to support you with making your application.
