**Wraparound price increase** - We have been running our Wraparound Club for over six years now and have kept the prices the same for all that time. With increased staffing, heating and lighting costs we will now have to increase our prices.

From Monday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2019 the costs will be as follows:

7.45 am - 8.50 am  $- \pounds 4.00$  - this remains the same

3.15pm (3pm on a Friday ) – 4.30pm – now £4.50 – increase of 50p a session

3.15pm – 5.30pm – now £7 -increase of 50p a session

4.15pm – 5.30pm - (after sports clubs etc) £4.50 – increase of 50p a session
