Pop-Up Swimming Pool - On Tuesday 14th May we will take delivery of a temporary pop-up swimming pool. The pool is heated and is 15 metres x 5 metres in size. A qualified swimming coach will teach small groups of children (max. 10 at

a time) and a qualified lifeguard will also be present during all lessons. The pool will be erected on the KS1 playground and will be here until 10th June. The priority will be for all the Year 5 and 6 children to be able to swim 25 metres by the end of the 2 weeks. We are hoping that all children from Reception to Year 6 will have access to at least one session and that this will become an annual event. I will send more details out next week.
