

## Wraparound

The Government has issued guidance for before and after school clubs during the pandemic, and how they should operate to maintain the health and wellbeing of pupils and staff. The guidance dictates that groups in a school the size of Our Lady's should be no larger than 15 pupils and 2 staff for each session, and that those groups should remain the same. This means that we will only be able to offer 15 places throughout the school for before school/breakfast club and wraparound club after school. You must commit to a place for Autumn term, and we will review the situation as guidance changes, or in readiness for Spring term 2021.

Priority will be given to full time bookings on a first come first served basis. Any spaces available after those bookings are confirmed will be offered again on a first come, first served basis.

There will be an expectation that you will pay for your child's place, whether or not they attend. This may seem unreasonable, but unfortunately, we have to impose this rule or withdraw the provision completely. We must be able to cover the costs of the wraparound club, or close it altogether. This is a temporary condition due to COVID 19, and will be reviewed termly. With your support, closing the wraparound is something we hope to avoid.

We will operate a first come first served waiting list for those who are not successful with their booking in the first instance.
