Week beginning 25th January Traditional Tales (Goldilocks and the Three Bears)

DAILY WRITING

In this week's lessons we will learn about 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Please try to complete one lesson per day. The lessons can be found here:

Monday — practise writing your name. If you can do this, start practising your surname too.

Activities to be completed over the week

Discuss who the characters in the story are (Goldilocks, Daddy bear, Mummy bear and Baby bear). Which of these characters made the wrong choice? Why? What did they do wrong?

Look at the three bears, who was the biggest bear? Who was the smallest? Can you find some things around your house that might belong to 'big' Daddy bear? Can you find some things that might belong to 'little' baby bear? These items could be items of clothing? Cutlery? Cups? Plates? Now can you find any that might belong to Mummy bear? She was medium sized (smaller than Daddy bear but bigger than baby bear). Can you put these items in order from smallest to biggest?

Can you make your own character masks using paper/card, decide who is going to be Goldilocks and the Bear/s. Can the children remember the repeated phrases that each character says? E.g. "Someone's been eating/sitting/sleeping...)"

Can you help your Parents/Carers to make breakfast? What is your favourite breakfast? We would love to see you helping to make it (as long as it is safe to do so).
