
#### Welcome Back

#### **Travelling to School**

I have started the school year as I mean to go on by cycling to work and I am encouraging more families to follow my example by walking, cycling or scooting to school. Teachers also find that pupils who walk and cycle arrive at school more relaxed, alert and ready to start the day than those who travel by car. It also reduces the risk of Covid transmission.

#### **Lunch Orders**

We are trialling a new lunch order system via our texting system T2P. Moving forward you will receive a text message on a Wednesday asking you to select your child's lunch choice for the following week. Please complete on receipt. If you do not respond it will mean, we are unable to add your child's lunch order to the system. If you have any questions, please contact the school office.

#### **Face Masks**

Current government guidance is that children in nurseries and primary schools do not need to wear a face covering. If, however, you do choose to send your child into school with a face mask we ask that you send in a small plastic bag to put it.

#### **School Uniform**

School uniform can be purchased through Eduspot again, once the order has been received by the office the uniform will be sent home with your child.

#### **Children's Boot Fund**

The Boot Fund application forms are available from the school office for those parents who are receiving certain benefits. Application forms need to be returned by Friday 18 September.

#### **First Holy Communion**
