This Week's Highlights

Reception

This week Reception Class have been learning about postal workers and how they help us. We opened our 'Christmas Post Office' role-play area and had fun decorating our Christmas tree. In R.E we have been thinking about Advent and talking about ways that we can prepare for Jesus' birthday.

Year 1

Year 1 have worked so hard in Maths and English this week; Miss Punch and Mrs Sloan are so very proud of them! In PE, we have been learning ball skills. We know how to kick a ball with the inside of our foot and how to stop the ball with our soles. Our favourite part of the week was decorating the classroom for Christmas and listening to classic Christmas songs.

Year 2

This week Year 2 have been learning about poetry in English. In Maths we have started understanding multiplication. We are also being busy preparing for the Nativity singing songs and learning our lines.

Year 3

We begin Advent this week with making our Advent promises and writing prayers of hope, peace, joy and love in Year 3 RE. We also discussed what if Mary had said 'No' and the children came up with really good thoughts on this from 'there would be no Christmas or Easter' to there would be 'No Saviour'. We decided we were very glad Mary said 'Yes' to the Angel Gabrielle. Our Ukulele playing goes from strength to strength and we are preparing a short Christmas concert which will hopefully be uploaded to dojo or twitter.

<u>Year 4</u>

Year 4 have been learning a lot about perimeters, rectilinear shapes and how to draw a rectilinear shape to specified measurements with careful use of a ruler. In RE, Year 4, have been learning about the Family Tree of Jesus and discussing how many names they know from his linear of ancestry and in English the children have written a synopsis of the poem ' Overheard on a Saltmarsh'.

<u>Year 5</u>

In Year 5 this week we have been writing fantastic descriptions about Diagon Alley in English, we have learnt how to calculate the area of a shape in maths and we have begun our unit about Advent in RE. The children discussed about how they would feel if they were Zechariah and wrote some brilliant reflections.

Year 6

Year 6 have been using their Science skills to make their own air raid sirens. The children had to make their own circuit with working lights and buzzers, as well as make their own box to display it in.

COVENTRY EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME FAQS

1. What is the EU Settlement Scheme?

 The UK Scheme to help EU/EEA citizens and family members to secure their right to stay in the UK and access to benefits, healthcare and pensions

2. Who should apply?

- All EU/EEA citizens apart from Irish nationals and those who have acquired British Citizenship (unless applying on behalf of family members)
- Adults may need to apply on behalf of children, family members or carers
- Family members include spouse, civil partner, partner, child, grandchild or great-grandchild, dependent parent, grandparent, greatgrandparent, dependent relative
- EU/EEA citizens with permanent residence.
 EEA citizens who were previously granted Indefinite Leave to Remain don't have to apply, but may which to do so as proof of residence
- · See full list of nationalities on page 2

3. Why apply?

Coventry City Council

- New rules will apply to all EEA nationals who arrive in the UK on or after 1 January 2021
- All EEA nationals in the UK before 1 January 2021 must apply before 30 June 2021 to ensure that they remain in the UK lawfully

4. How long do I have to apply?

The EU Settlement Scheme closes
 30 June 2021

5. What is the process to apply? What do I need?

- There are only 3 requirements:
- 1. Proof of identity and nationality (passport, ID card, residence card/permit etc.)
- Proof of length of residency in UK (address, National Insurance number, bank statement, P60/P45, bills etc.)
- 3. Undergo a criminality check

6. How can I access support and advice?

 There is FREE, independent and confidential support available to anyone. This includes:

- i. Application support and advice
- ii. Document retrieval, evidencing residency etc.
- iii. Support in accessing services
- iv. Free legal advice
- v. Information sessions
- vi. Digital support
