Class Dojo

Class Dojo is the main way in which teachers communicate to parents on a day-to-day basis especially at the moment with the majority of our children working at home. It is a quick and easy way for parents to ask questions and get a quick response. Also, teachers can let you know how your child is getting on and share their work with you. If you have not already signed up, please do so. This will avoid you missing important updates that are just for your child. If you have already signed up, please make sure your notifications are turned on. Please contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions.

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Extra Clothing

In order to reduce the transmission of the virus, we are making sure that all our classrooms are well ventilated. For those children in school you may wish to send your child in with an extra layer of clothing to keep them warm during the colder weather. This could be a fleecy top or jumper, sports skins or even an extra pair of socks! If you find that providing extra clothing is difficult for you, please do not hesitate to contact the school for support.

Lunch Orders

For those children currently attending school, please continue to complete your child's lunch order weekly via our texting system T2P. The text messages will be sent every Tuesday; please ensure you respond with your child's lunch choice for the following week. The school orders food based on your selections and therefore if you do not respond it will mean we will contact you requesting you to provide a packed lunch for your child.
