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Church Carpark

Father Sebastian has been in touch with school regarding use of the Church carpark for dropping-off and picking-up children. He would like to thank the majority of parents who have worked with the Church and school to make sure that the carpark is a safe place for our children and who have respected the needs of the Priests when parking. Please try to drop-off and pick-up at the right time for your child to reduce the volume of traffic and avoid the need for cars to park for longer than necessary. Father has also asked that you move to the carpark nearest the gates when waiting rather than congregating on the Church carpark.

From the school's point of view, we are very grateful to Father Sebastian for allowing our parents and carers to use the Church carpark as I know this makes dropping-off and picking-up easier for you. You may have noticed that Mac, who works for the parish, has been monitoring the carpark. If Mac does speak to you about parking, please do not take offence as he is only doing so in order to make the carpark safe for pedestrians and drivers. If Father feels that parents and carers are not parking safely, or that individuals are not supportive of Mac when approached about parking, he may decide to close the carpark except for parish business.

Altar Servers

Would your child like to train to become an altar server? If so, and they have made their First Holy Communion, please let their teacher know that you are happy for us to pass on their name to the Parish Secretary. Father Sebastian is inviting all interested children to attend the 4.30pm mass on Boxing Day at OLA where he will welcome any new children. In the spring, your child will then begin training to serve. This is a wonderful opportunity for some of our pupils to become more involved in the parish and to grow in their faith.

Extra Clothing

In order to reduce the transmission of the virus, we are making sure that all our classrooms are well ventilated. You may wish to send your child in with an extra layer of clothing to keep them warm during the colder weather. This could be a fleecy top or jumper, sports skins or even an extra pair of socks!
