This Week's Highlights

Reception

Reception have been very busy learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali. We have learned about the story of Rama and Sita, made cards for Diwali and looked at rangoli patterns. In maths we have been using the words 'more' and 'fewer' to compare amounts of objects. In R.E we learned about the special celebrations of weddings.

Year 5



DISCO w/c 16 November: - Gloria Gaynor / Donna Summer

Gloria Gaynor – was born Gloria Fowles in Newark, New Jersey on September 7, 1943. Gloria is an American singer, best known for the disco era hits "I Will Survive" (1978), "Never Can Say Goodbye" (1974), "Let Me Know (I Have a Right)" (1979), and "I Am What I Am" (1983).

Donna Summer - (December 31, 1948 – May 17, 2012), LaDonna Adrian Gaines, widely known by her stage name based on her married name Donna Summer, was an American singer, songwriter and actress. She gained prominence during the disco era of the 1970s and became known as the "Queen of Disco", while her music gained a global following. She was known for her hits "I Feel Love" and "Last Dance".
