This Week's Highlights

Reception

This week is World Nursery Rhyme Week and we have been sharing our favourite nursery rhymes, as well as learning some new ones. As part of our 'People Who Help Us' topic we have been learning about police officers. We have also been talking about Road Safety and how to stay safe near the road.

Year 1

In maths, Year 1 have been looking at numbers to 20! They have created new school logos in DT and have made Road Safety posters in English.

Year 2

In topic, Year 2 learnt all about Nairobi and Masai Mara Park in Kenya. We then did some super writing comparing them. We have been trying really hard with our handwriting too.

<u>Year 3</u>

Year 3 have been writing a story about Claude - a dog who goes on lots of adventure. This week his adventure took place at the funfair. Our RE story this week was the anointing of Jesus with a precious oil

and we thought about the Act of Sorrow and what it means. We also entered the first stage of a pentathlon competition. Finally, we elected the children to represent us on the Pupil Parliament - well done Ruby and Riley.

Year 4

This week Year 4 have done some fantastic work, using bar models to help them solve addition and subtraction problems. They have also written some amazing recounts set in the Roman times.

<u>Year 5</u>

This week Year 5 have written their poems in the style of Kate Wakeling. They included imagery and poetic devices; I was very impressed! We have also learnt about the different Sacraments in RE, started our new Guided Reading groups and Year 5 really enjoyed learning about squared numbers in maths.

Year 6

Year 6 have been learning about discussion texts in English and are planning their own text. We have been continuing to develop our understanding of fractions and multiplied fractions and converted their answers. We have also looked at how to be safe on the roads when walking or cycling.

Extra Clothing

In order to reduce the transmission of the virus, we are making sure that all our classrooms are well ventilated.
