Reception

The **Bee Gees** were a music group formed in 1958. Their line-up consisted of brothers Barry, Robin, and Maurice Gibb. The trio were especially successful as a popular music act in the late 1960s and early 1970s, and later as prominent performers of the disco music era in the mid-tolate 1970s. Their famous hits were 'Stayin Alive', 'How Deep Is Your Love', 'Jive Talkin' and 'You Should Be Dancing'.
