#### Music appreciation

Dolly Rebecca Parton (born January 19, 1946) is an American singer, songwriter and actress, known primarily for her work in <u>country music</u>. After achieving success as a songwriter for others, Parton made her album debut in 1967 with <u>Hello, I'm Dolly</u>.

Parton's music includes 25 <u>Recording Industry Association of America</u> (RIAA)-certified gold, platinum and multi-platinum awards. She has had 25 songs reach No. 1 on the <u>Billboard</u> country music charts, a record for a female artist. She has 41 career top-10 country albums, a record for any artist, and she has 110 career charted singles over the past 40 years. She has garnered ten <u>Grammy Awards</u>, two <u>Academy Award</u> nominations, ten <u>Country Music Association Awards</u>, seven <u>Academy of Country Music Awards</u>, three <u>American Music Awards</u>, and is one of only seven female artists to win the Country Music Association's Entertainer of the Year Award. Parton has received 47 Grammy nominations.

In 1999, Parton was inducted into the <u>Country Music Hall of Fame</u>. She has composed over 3,000 songs, including "<u>I Will</u> <u>Always Love You</u>" (a two-time U.S. country chart-topper, as well as an international pop hit for <u>Whitney Houston</u>), "<u>Jolene</u>", and "<u>9 to 5</u>".


